English descriptions:

Arriving by train

- a) at Bonn main station, take train S line 6 direction Auerberg.
Get off at stop **Innenministerium**, after 50 metres on the right hand side direction city you reach the CJD.
- b) at ICE station in **Siegburg–Bonn** take train S Line 66 direction Bad Honnef Stadtbahn. Get off at stop Stadthaus and change to S line 61, direction Auerberg, get off at stop **Innenministerium**.
After 50 metres on the right hand side direction city you reach the CJD.

Arriving by plane at Airport Köln/Bonn

- c) take the airport bus SB 60 to Bonn main station get off at stop **Innenministerium**, and after 50 metres on the right hand side direction city you reach the CJD.

Arriving by plane at Airport Düsseldorf take sky train to airport station

- d) take an ICE to Köln or Frankfurt get off at station **Siegburg–Bonn** (continue see b)).
- e) take a train to Köln (Cologne). Change at Cologne main station to a train to Bonn.
At Bonn main station follow a).
